DEAN'S MESSAGE

In my last year of the deanship, it is rewarding to look upon the 35th graduating MBA class with pride. This year, 35 members of the first graduating class of the EXECUTIVE MBA PROGRAM join the growing number of graduates from the full-time and part-time MBA programs.

It is a good-year to be a graduate! After a few years in the doldrums, the Canadian economy is strong and



our placement office has been very successful in placing our graduates with leading Canadian institutions. More important, the growing reputation of FMS is bringing ever larger numbers of companies to recruit our graduates.

FMS is moving in many new directions, with new degree and non-degree programs, new funding initiatives and new faculty. The school's endowed funds are now close to \$1.5 million, including three endowed professorships. New teaching and research institutes are being established in Organizational Effectiveness, Resource Management and Retailing. New programs in accounting at the Master's and Doctoral level are being planned. By 1990, over half the school's revenue will be derived from programs initiated from 1983 onwards. As a consequence, in spite of declining government budgets, the financial stability of FMS will be maintained. Finally, after long delays, the faculty will have a new computer system by the fall of 1985 and a large number of new micro computers as well.

We hope that you will continue to share in our success and our new directions through active participation in our expanding alumni association. Through our own alumni publication, Toronto Business Reports, and the alumni newsletter, we will keep you informed about FMS. Good luck!
